70 days. Expect huge crops of "black," pear-shaped tomatoes over a very long season. Chocolate Pear has the rich tomato flavor that has made heirlooms so popular!



GG's Glory Cherry

Sweet yellow cherry tomatoes that almost have a grape crunch to them. The cutest little Christmas Tree-shaped plant around 18 inches tall, that makes the fruits look like golden Christmas ornaments. Great for a patio container.



Chocolate Cherry

The 1-in. cherry-like fruits are rich brick red with deep chocolate shading. These luscious treats are perfect for salads, slicing or canning with an exceptional fresh flavor that is rich and complex. 70 DAYS.



PURPLE BUMBLE BEE60-70 days.

Slightly elongated little cherries with the most outrageous striping in lime green and bronzy-purple! Crack-resistant fruit is produced all season long on plants that are unfazed by temperature extremes. The flavor is complex but sweet.



Dwarf Mocha's Cherry

65 days, *dwarf* — 'Dwarf Mocha's Cherry' has compact, eighteen to twenty inch tall plants.. The fruit are abundant, round, small (about one ounce each), and a glossy deep purple color, some with green shoulders, that becomes nearly black when exposed to the sun.



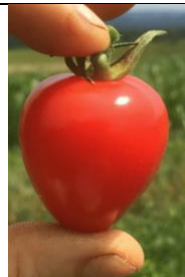
Dwarf Eagle Smiley

60 days, *dwarf* — 'Dwarf Eagle Smiley' look like a smaller version of a standard cherry-type tomato plant, reaching about five feet in height. They are extremely productive and loaded with one ounce, bright to golden-yellow, globe-shaped fruit in clusters of eight to ten tomatoes.



Fruit Punch Cherry

Big sprawling plant that yield a prolific crops of 1 oz., round, pink, thin-skinned fruit that fruity sweet. Surprisingly crack resistant, even in heavy rains, considering the delicate thin skin.



Gardener's Sweetheart Cherry

Endearing heart-shape of these super sweet, crack-resistant cherries that melt in your mouth.

Cherry Tomatoes



Marmande

French heirloom. Historically a popular variety grown for market. Indeterminate, regular leaf plants produce clusters of 6-10 ounce deep red, slightly flattened, oblate fruits that are meaty, lightly lobed and contain an excellent, complex, slightly tart taste.



Pruden's Purple

Large Indeterminate, potato, leaf plant produces lots of 1-lb., slightly flattened, pretty, blemish-free, purple-pink fruits with few tomato seeds and excellent flavor. A good choice for slicing into sandwiches, salads or even sauces.



San Marzano Vesuvio

Campania tomato characterized by an indeterminate, vigorous and covering plant for greenhouse and open field crops. The fruits, with their typical elongated shape and characteristic flavor.



Stump O' The World

Indeterminate, potato leaf plant produces a good yield of large, 1 lb., pink, very meaty tomatoes with superb flavor. Small seed cavity. An historic and VERY popular variety for marketplace appeal. RARE



Dwarf Audrey's Love

'Dwarf Audrey's Love' plants grow to only 3' but will provide you an abundant crop of 3-4 oz., elongated plum-shaped, paste-type fruit with a beautiful mahogany coloring, green striping and dark-green shoulders.



Dwarf Caiitydid

Indeterminate, dwarf plants with regular leaf foliage produces lots of 3-8 oz., smooth, oblate bi-colored, yellow tomatoes with red swirls outside, and heavy red coloration in the flesh. The flavor is well balanced and delicious.



Chocolate Lightning

Indeterminate, dwarf plants with that produce 4-8 oz., medium-sized, chocolate-brown, slightly-oblate, slicers with jagged green and gold stripes. The rich crimson flesh has intense and well-balanced flavors.



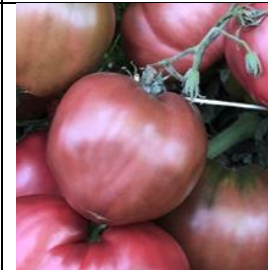
German Golden Strawberry

Indeterminate plant produces moderate crop of 14 oz., heart, gold-colored tomatoes. Sweet, tropical fruit flavors. RARE.



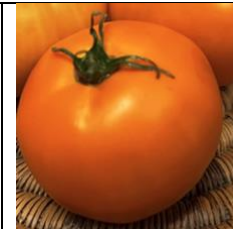
Pink Passion

Determinate, vigorous, dwarf plants with rugose regular leaf foliage produce heavy yields of 4-8 oz., pink, medium-sized, strongly heart-shaped fruits with delightful, balanced, sweet flavors.



Purple Heart

Determinate, dwarf plants with rugose regular leaf foliage produce heavy yields of 6-16 oz., medium-large, heart-shaped, purple-black tomatoes with deep-crimson flesh with a delicious well-balanced flavors.



Rosella Crimson – Dwarf
 Determinate, dwarf (tree-type) plants with regular rugose foliage produce good crops of 4-13 oz., pink beefsteak tomatoes with very delicious, well-balanced flavors.

Dwarf Strawberry Lemonade
 Produce lots of medium to large, ranging from eight to fourteen ounces, crimson pink colored, oblate-shaped, juicy tomatoes with a mild, well balanced, delightful flavor. This is a perfect meaty slicing tomato that lovers of pink fruited, sweet heirloom types will appreciate.

Uluru Ochre – Dwarf
 Indeterminate, compact ('tree-type') plants with rugose, regular leaf foliage produce prolific amounts of 6-12 oz... The flavors of this variety are superb with full, well-balanced, fruity tartness to balance the sweetness.

Dwarf Wild Spudleaf
 Indeterminate, vigorous dwarf (tree-type) plants with potato leaf rugose foliage produce abundant yields of 6-12 oz., smooth, oblate, purple (clear skin) fruits, with rich, well balanced delicious flavors.

Dad's Sunset
 Uniformly round, meaty, 10-14 oz., (2-3 inches), smooth, golden-orange tomatoes (the color of the setting sun). Slightly tart, yet a delightful sweet, fruity flavor. One of the best tasting tomatoes. A beautiful tomato on the vine or in the bowl. On cloudy days, when my sons were small they would occasionally deliver me one of these delights from the garden at the end of the day to bring me the "sunset." Wonderful salad tomato.



Dagma's Russian Yellow
 Large, indeterminate plant produces an abundant crop of beautiful yellow beefsteak shaped 12-14 oz. deliciously sweet tomatoes without the pronounced acidic tang.

Oaxacan Jewel
 A pre-Columbian Mexican heirloom tomato. Indeterminate, regular leaf plant that produces beautiful 1-2 pound, yellow beefsteak tomato with red streaks throughout the fruit with brilliant red marbling inside the flesh. Wonderfully rich, sweet, fruity flavors with a well-balanced acidic finish.

Yellow Bosnian
 Old heirloom tomato from Yugoslavia, shorter, regular leaf, indeterminate that produce a very heavy yield of 10 oz., slightly flattened, yellow, oblate beefsteak tomatoes with deliciously rich, well-balanced, slightly sweet flavors. RARE

Black Prince
 Deep garnet round, 2-inch (2-3 oz.) tomatoes are full of juice and incredibly rich fruity flavors. This is a tomato that chefs I deliver to rave about for it's rich flavors.

Cherokee Chocolate
 Big, sprawling vigorous plants that yield 3-4-inch, 10-14 oz., mahogany-colored beefsteak tomatoes. Cherokee Chocolate has developed a great following among celebrity chefs because of its exceptionally rich, complex, tomato flavors and wonderful chocolaty appearance.

Very productive plants producing loads of dusky rose to purple colored, 12-16 oz., beefsteak tomatoes with deep red color to the interior flesh and dark shoulders.

Dwarf Chocolate Heartthrob

Its fruit are six to ten ounces each, strongly heart-shaped, and a rich mahogany chocolate in color with nearly metallic looking green stripes. The interior is a rich burgundy crimson with a well balanced, very delicious and classic "tomato-ey" flavor.



Rumpelstiltskin Dwarf

Indeterminate that is a steady producer of these yellow striped fruits. Weights are between 5-7oz for these beefsteaks. The flavors are sweet, fruity with a little acidity a really good taste.



Tennessee Surprise

Indeterminate, regular-leaf tomato plants that yield moderate to heavy crops of 12-16 oz., orange-yellow beefsteak tomatoes with very subtle red blushing/striping. Slightly pleated fruit contains excellent sweet, well-balanced, old-time tomato flavors.



Lillian's Yellow

Indeterminate tomato plants that yield 10-16 oz., clear to orangy-yellow, fragile, thin-skinned, beefsteak tomatoes that have mildly sweet, citrusy flavors, juicy flesh and very few seeds.



Kellogg's Breakfast

15-32 oz., pale to deep orange beefsteak tomatoes that are thin-skinned, meaty, have few seeds and a fantastic sweet, tangy flavor. Juice and inside flesh have the same bright orange color as orange juice.

Dwarf Zoe's Sweet

Dwarf Zoe's Sweet is a chartreuse-colored taller potato leaf dwarf with medium to large oblate pink fruit (6-12 ounces) I decided to name it Zoe's Sweet, after his beloved black lab. The flavor is on the sweet side, and the texture is as meaty as its parent, Mortgage Lifter.

Dwarf Metallica

Grows two to three feet in height. It fruit range from four to sixteen ounces each, are pink in color with green stripes, oblate to slightly heart shaped, and deliver a flavor that is well-balanced; slightly sweet and tangy.



Banksia Queen

Produces a good yield of medium to medium large sized (six to twelve ounce) oblate, bright yellow tomatoes, with occasional lobing. 'Banksia Queen' has delicious, juicy, pale yellow flesh with a good balance of sweet and tart.



Dwarf Oriole

The fruit are smooth skinned, oblate shaped, six to twenty ounces each, and bright pale orange in color. Many fruit will show a lovely, pale pink color. They have an intense, well balanced flavor and lovely juicy texture.



Loxton Lad

The vigorous, productive, rugose, regular leaf dwarf plants produce smooth, orange, oblate-shaped fruit that range between six to sixteen ounces in weight, with a well-balanced, delicious flavor.



Polish

The plants are a potato-leaf type that produce large (weighing about one pound), moderately smooth, flattened globe in shape, pink fruit. Other seed suppliers have called its color "brick red," but it is a pink variety by definition; clear skin over red flesh. The flavor are excellent and comparable to the best heirloom varieties.



Dester

The regular leaf plants of 'Dester' produce large (six to twenty-four ounce), pink, beefsteak-type, oblate shaped fruits. It is an excellent, tasty slicing tomato.
